G'day guys,

Thanks very much for this calendar! I've only got a couple of issues, which I'm hoping are easy fixes :)

Firstly, if you go here:

http://test.simonwatson.com.au/joomla/index.php?option=com_iwebcal&Itemid=55

...you'll see that the calendar has a string of text above it, displaying the location of the calendar. Can I get rid of that?

Also, I'm losing some of the information for each event. I'm using a script to get calendar information out of Outlook, and save it as an ics file - get the ics at [http://test.simonwatson.com.au/joomla/components/com_iwebcal/calendars/Simon Watson.ics](http://test.simonwatson.com.au/joomla/components/com_iwebcal/calendars/Simon%20Watson.ics). Does iWebCal not display location? I have only got location in that ics once (for testing), which is the 28th of March.

If you click on details inside a day, you get this error message:
