The issue is the RSS feed that I have setup (using mod_syndicate) for the section blog I have setup that uses the {enclosure} tag doesn't render the player when it shows up in RSS readers like Google reader. Any ideas?

Thanks for using the suite! No, the plugin is only supposed to transform the {enclosure ...} tag on your site and not in your feed. The articles that you publish your podcasts in are only meant to be fed into the RSS feed generated by the Podcast Suite. This way, the {enclose ...} tag gets changed to an tag in the RSS feed.

Im hoping I may get a little bit of help on a possible fix for this. All Im trying to create is a PODCAST page, the page being a section blog layout menu item: my live page is at http://www.mymorningrush.com/index.php?option=com_content&view=section&layout=blog&id=5&Itemid=71

My "ENCLOSE" tag is not being turned into the link as it is designed. My apologies as I'm not a programmer so code is a bit confusing to me. I've now tried to un-install the PODCAST SUITE. The module was a clean uninstall. The component was a clean uninstall. But when trying to uninstall the PLUGIN, I receive the following error:

Plugin Uninstall: Manifest File invalid or not found

When I re-install the COMPONENT, it is a clean install. When I re-install the MODULE, it is a clean install. When re-installing the PLUGIN, I receive the following error:

Plugin Install: Plugin "podcast" Already Exists!

When I tried to install the PATCH, I receive the following error:

Error! Could not find an XML setup file in the package.

This is a really important feature for my client as they are a Top 40 morning radio show. Your suite comes highly recommended and frankly, looks like the only real option out there! It seems almost too easy to get up and running, which is why Im so frustrated. I really appreciate your help if you have the time.

I'm trying to find the articles where you've published your podcast episodes, can you guide me to them?

As far as uninstalling goes, it sounds like you have some oddities going on with your server. Normally, it's just supposed to remove the files. I'm wondering if there's a file permission issue? Try going to plugins/content and removing podcast.php and podcast.xml manually, then try installing again.

Also, the patch .zip is not designed to be installed through the installer. Unzip it and copy the files over the existing ones in the plugins/content folder. Sorry for the confusion!

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
